

## **Services Offered at Fairford Nursery (Fairford Academy Barnehurst, Bexley)**

Fairford Academy Barnehurst provides **school-based nursery education** for children aged **3–4 years**.

### **1. Part-Time Nursery Sessions (Morning & Afternoon Places)**

The nursery offers:

- **26 morning places**
- **26 afternoon places**  
For children **aged 3–4 years old**.

These are structured early-years sessions aligned with the **EYFS (Early Years Foundation Stage)**, as is standard across Bexley primary school nurseries.

### **2. Nursery Admissions & Parent Support**

The school provides:

- Guidance on how to apply for a nursery place
- Contact support via telephone and email

Parents can apply through the Bexley Council nursery admissions system.

### **3. Inclusive, School-Based Learning Environment**

Fairford Academy Barnehurst emphasises:

- **A fully inclusive culture**
- Supportive early-years environment

The nursery is part of a primary school setting, giving children access to structured learning and safe outdoor/play areas typical of a school EYFS environment.

We do not directly accept payments through Tax-Free Childcare or Universal Credit Childcare for nursery fees".

However, parents who use either scheme *can still claim back eligible childcare costs* in the following way:

How this works in our setting

- Parents pay the nursery fees to us in the usual way.
- We then provide any required invoices or payment confirmations so that parents can submit these to:
  - HMRC if they are using a Tax-Free Childcare account, or

- Universal Credit through their online journal if they are claiming the childcare element.
- Families are responsible for managing the process of claiming back the eligible amount through their chosen scheme.

We will always support parents by supplying the correct documentation on time to ensure their claims run smoothly
